Frequently Asked Questions

Will the City know who filled out each survey?

No. All answers were anonymous. The only demographic questions listed on the survey were age, employment status, school system status, and City district where you live / do business.

How will the survey answers be used by the City of Stonecrest?

The feedback provided by the community participants of this survey will directly affect the use of the funds.

The data collected will be compiled and summarized to guide City officials in selecting activities and programs for funding.

When will we see the results of the survey?

The results are available now on the City's website. Visit <u>www.stonecrestga.gov</u>, then click **STONECREST FORWARD**.

Will we know how the City of Stonecrest spent all the funds?

Yes. How the money is spent is considered public information by the City of Stonecrest.

All expenditures will be shown, eventually adding up to the total of \$9.7 million.

The City of Stonecrest will show the monies as spent, so that at any point in the process, the total paid out will be noted along with each component of the 'running total' as it is spent.

What is the timeline for distributing the funds?

The City is reviewing the survey's results and working diligently to determine the best uses of the funds and will begin distribution as soon as feasible.
