Stonecrest Bicycle, Pedestrian & Trail Plan



The City of Stonecrest is in the process of developing a comprehensive Bicycle, Pedestrian and Trail Plan that will deliver a safe, connected, and integrated multimodal network blueprint. The planning process will result in a Recommendations and Implementation Plan that will identify a long-range vision, project, and strategies crucial to achieving the integrated multimodal network developed through this plan.

Project Phases

- **Public Involvement**: Opportunities to provide input will be ongoing throughout the process. Initial public involvement will focus on identifying existing system conditions and future system needs. Later public involvement will focus on obtaining feedback on system proposals.
- Existing Conditions Inventory/Policy & Plan Review: The project team will review and assess the City's existing trail network. This assessment will help inform what work needs to be done to further develop the City's multi-modal network.
- **System Appraisal & Evaluation**: During this phase, the project team will determine existing and future needs for pedestrian, bicycle and trail development.
- **Bicycle, Pedestrian & Trail Network Development**: Upon appraising the existing system, the team will develop recommendations for an integrated network of multimodal facilities.
- **Recommendation & Implementation Plan**: Finally, the project team will identify a longrange vision, projects, and strategies for an integrated and comprehensive trail network.
